Submission Guidelines for Man, Alive!

Man Alive! is a quarterly publication of New Mexico Men's Wellness, intended to present material of interest and value to the men's community. We are always looking for photographs, drawings and other art work, poetry, stories, essays, memoir, personal experiences, anecdotes, etc. Fiction and letters for publication are also considered. (Suggestions, comments, questions are welcome anytime.) Issue themes and deadlines are sent out to the NMMW email list and available on the website: **nmmw.org/man-alive** The website has the email address to use for submissions or letters. Submissions of relevant materials are accepted from anyone, not just NMMW participants. The editors reserve the right to accept or reject submissions, suggest edits, or reserve for publication in a later issue. Formatting guidelines are detailed below. Print submissions are generally not accepted. Please clearly identify the author/artist and provide contact information. A brief (50 words or less) biographical statement is optional.

For Submission of Written Material

The preferred formats for submitted pieces are Open Document (.odt) or Microsoft Word (.docx). Plain text (.txt) or "rich text" (.rtf) are acceptable, as is text inline with email. Adobe PDF is not a suitable format for submissions. The suggested maximum length is 1,500 words.

For Submissions of Graphical Material

We can accept a variety of digital image formats, but not PDF. Images can accompany written material or be intended for standalone use, e.g. cover image, photo spread, etc. Regarding image resolution, be aware that final conversion to PDF for publishing reduces image resolution to 300 DPI, so high resolution images aren't necessary. An image may be resized to fit a page or space as needed.
